

St Marks Church, Newby

The Trust was delighted to assist St Mark's Church in Newby with a grant of £8,500 towards the cost of replacing the main nave roof in June 2017.

The Church hoped to complete the work by Spring 2018 but the presence of bats delayed this. As it was necessary to apply for a licence to undertake the 'bat work', it took a year to complete work on the roof – but it is now complete.
